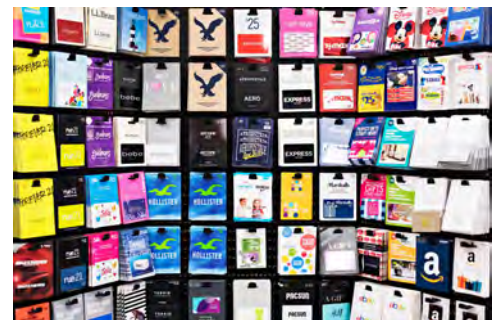

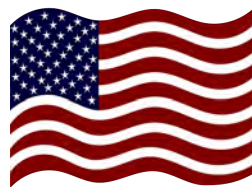
Once again for those that are competing, we will not be judging any differently than the previous years. This school was just a tool for teaching and keeping all on the same page.

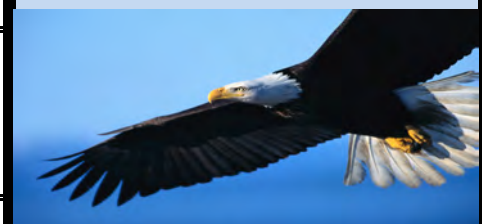
